Stanley M. Street **President**

Stanley Street has been in the financial services industry for more than thirty-two years, the last twenty of which as Owner and President of his financial technology services company Street Resource Group, Inc. (SRG). SRG provides mortgage industry related financial information management systems and consulting services to a nationwide corporate client base. Mr. Street's strong background in accounting and finance, mortgage lending technology, and financial industry operations gives him a unique perspective and hybrid set of skills.

Prior to founding SRG, Mr. Street served as Vice President at First American Bank in Atlanta, Georgia and received this recognition at the age of 26. As Financial Systems manager, he was responsible for completely automating the financial planning, analysis and reporting department. He then created and managed the Software Systems and Services department in the Correspondent Banking Division, which provided system analysis, software design, programming, implementation assistance and user training. He also conducted seminars and workshops for bank employees.

Street's earlier professional experience included the position of Divisional Controller - Community Banking at First Atlanta Corporation. He later became the Accounting Systems Manager at Northwestern Bank in Wilkesboro, North Carolina. Originally from Savannah, GA, Mr. Street began his industry career there at Great Southern Savings & Loan as an Assistant Controller.

David Brackin, CPA **Chief Software Architect**



David Brackin is the Chief Software Architect at Street Resource Group, Inc. (SRG). His primary responsibilities include engineering and managing the design and development of the .NET/SQL2000-based Warehouse Loan System application, SRG's key product. A professional programmer for the past ten years, Mr. Brackin previously worked for five years as a CPA.

Before creating the .NET platform application for SRG, Mr. Brackin was the technical lead at USgift.com, a \$100 million business-to-business web site funded by Internet Capital Group; and then at Supplier Capital, a factoring software company, where he automated data transmission processes. Prior to these positions he was the senior software engineer on OneCoast Network's sales force automation software.

In the late 1990s, Mr. Brackin served as the lead architect at the number 8-ranked web directory company, KnowX.com, which processed over 100,000 transactions per day. This site was featured in the Wall Street Journal and on Good Morning America. While there, David transformed the web site, redesigning all of the CGIs, credit card applications and the entire database and web server configuration.

Mr. Brackin began his programming career as a software engineer in the mid-90s at Reuters Health Information Services after graduating from the University of Alabama and serving as a CPA at Agee Fisher and Company and TimeCorp Systems.
